Comfort Quilt Checklist

We **really** appreciate all donations of tops or finished quilts! In order to make the Comfort Quilt Committee's job easier, here are some tips.

If you are turning in a quilt top, please check:

- All pieced seams are complete and close to $\frac{1}{4}$ " everywhere, and there are no "holes" in the top
- Whenever possible, seams are pressed to the same side
- Stray threads and lint have been removed
- All pins have been removed

If you are turning in a completed quilt, please check:

- If quilted, quilting is no more than 5" apart, and thread starts and stops have been secured and clipped
- If tied, quilts are tied no more than 5" apart, and tied ends are clipped to around the same length (1/2 - 1")
- If the quilt has binding, the binding is securely sewn down on both top and back of quilt
- Stray threads and lint have been removed
- All pins have been removed
- If available, a label has been sewn to back

If the quilt or top was part of a comfort quilt kit, please return any leftover fabric, batting, bags, directions, rubber bands, etc. for reuse.
